Meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M.

Approve Minutes: Motion by Voy, 2ed by Glawe, to approve minutes, all voting yes, motion passed.

Public Appearances: Dan Buckner for the Phoenix Group asking for the use of amplified music for music in the park to run from June 3ed to Sept 30th Motion by Glawe, 2ed by Voy to approve the request, motion passed will move on to council for approval. Also informed the board that new bids for the Teen Center project has risen from \$18,000 to \$32,825 which was not in their budget. Dan asked that the City not tear it down this year and give them time to raise the money needed to fund the project.

Parks Report: Doors at Discher Park were removed and painted to remove the vandalism. The benches at the street scape were removed and are being powerd coated to remove the rust. Have gotten new wind curtains for the tennis courts.

Aquatic Center Report: Worked on the Aquatic Center flyer for this year. Approved the changes to the flyer so they can go to publication next month.

Rec Report: The basketball season will end with a league tournament on Feb 21/22. Little Dribblers got to show off their skills at the half time of the Varsity Girls game on Feb 12, and will do it again at a Boys game. Indoor T-ball started Feb 18th at Van Brunt Gym. Fitness class start Feb 25th at City hall. Dan is working on the Spring and Summer programs.

A request from the Rotary Club to build a 16x20 open air Shelter at Rotary Park the club will be funding the project. Will pass on to council for approval.

Park Recommendations: Reviewed the list of Park Improvements from last month and will have them placed on the Park Plan so we can apply for any grants that we can apply for. Still looking into cost for some of the ideas.

Non-Action: Will have the Dog Park, Teen Center, City Bike trail put on March agenda.
